

Benoki – because you can't plan everything

There are situations in everyday life that bring parents into great distress regarding the care of their children, such as illness, traffic jam, cancelling of school hours, overtime work, etc. In these exceptional situations, trained volunteers from Benoki come and help, so that the children are not left alone.

How does Benoki work?

Children from 0-14 years are cared for free by trained helpers in emergency situations. The concerned parents can connect us through a toll free number. They are available from 6 am to 9 pm. The care can be offered at home, in the day care center, in the school or in an own care room. The care will take effect until a parent or another caregiver takes over the child.
